



THE COMMUNICANTS PROCESS

at Cahaba Park

If you feel that your child is ready to become a communing member of Cahaba Park this is what the process will look like...



1. ATTEND THE COMMUNICANTS CLASS

At Cahaba Park we offer a Communicants Class once a year that children attend with at least one parent. All curriculum and materials are provided. Be on the lookout for sign ups in the church newsletter or feel free to email Laura Wilder with any questions (lwilder@cahabapark.org)

2. PARENT CONVERSATION WITH A PASTOR/ELDER

If, after the class, you feel that your child is ready to make a public profession of faith, take membership vows, and come to the Lord's Table, you will contact Laura Wilder to set up a brief meeting between a pastor/designated elder and yourself (parent/guardian) to discuss your child's profession of faith.

3. ELDER INTERVIEW

Parents/guardians will then be contacted with a date for your child's interview with elders (It is important to note that everyone who becomes a member of Cahaba Park Church goes through a membership interview.)



4. JOIN DURING WORSHIP

Upon completion of a membership interview, and affirmation from the elders of your child's profession of faith, your child will be a communing member of the church.
